Dear Parents / Carers

December is almost upon us and our thoughts are already turning towards planning the end of term activities. The students voted to have, as their end of term activity, a game of Quasar or trampolining at High Altitude or for those who don't wish to do either a video at school. These are a reward for those who have worked hard and behaved well this term.

Unfortunately we have the occasional student who falls short of our expectations and their parent / carers expectations.

Therefore, this year we are introducing a merit system for the next two weeks. This will consist of a uniform check first thing in the morning, a mark for each lesson as well as a mark for break and lunch time behaviour, a total of 10 per day.

Students will be expected to reach a minimum of 80% over the two weeks with most expected to achieve 100%.

Students will arrive in full school uniform (details attached) every day. On Tuesdays the group doing the Hair and Beauty course will then change ready for college. This group will change back again into school uniform when they arrive back in school before returning to lessons on Tuesday afternoon. The group doing Construction will change into their steel toe capped boots and overalls at college and also change back into school uniform before returning to college.

On Wednesdays those doing PE in periods 1 and 2, will change into their PE kit when at school and as they return at the end of break they have their snack in period 3 and change after eating their lunch and before period 5.

On Thursdays when the students get to college they must wear full chef's clothing and so place their sweatshirts, ties and blazers in the store room as usual. Once everyone has cleared up they will then change back into their full school uniform before having the privilege of going to the College canteen. No fizzy drinks may be purchased otherwise this privilege will be stopped.

We expect that all students will achieve more than the 80% target. Any students that are not meeting the target will be informed as well as their parents / carers and improvements made to help them achieve the desired outcome.

If this is not achieved, meetings with parents / carers will be required to determine how to proceed.
