Spring Term 2018

English

Complete the study and annotation of poems in the 'Power and Conflict' section of AQA anthology, look at sample exam questions comparing 2 poems. Revise the skills of approaching an unseen poem and ways of tackling the 2 questions on the last part of Literature paper 2.

Complete last term's revision of Dickens' 'A Christmas Carol' and also revise 'Macbeth'. In both cases, we will focus on the skills of analyzing an extract and writing about the whole novel/play, as required in Literature paper 1.

Work on mock exam papers for English Language and on the Spoken Language presentation to be submitted to AQA next term.

Maths

Foundation Curriculum students targeted grades 4-5 will be learning the following:

Unit 9 Geometry

Conclusion last term's works. Finding volumes of spheres, pyramids and cones. Similar shapes.

Unit 10 Statistics

Review previous statistic work, examine trends, draw a line of best fit and use of estimating, take samples.

Unit 11 Geometry

Review previous work, construct with compasses, draw loci, use plans and elevations, use Pythagoras' theorem, use trigonometry.

Radioactivity

Calculations involving masses

Electrolytic processes, obtaining and using metals, reversible reactions and equilibria

ICT

GCSE Students will be working on Activity 2 & 3 of their Controlled Assessment paperwork and working through the Theory ICT Revision Workbook.

All remaining students will be working towards Functional Skills L2.

Word: Creating Tables, inserting images, Page Design and Layout, Printing Options, Mail merge

Excel: Using advanced formulae: Using functions and What if Statements, HLookup, VLookup and Absolute and Relative cell referencing exercises.
Towards the latter part of the term they will be working through past papers.
