Dear Parents and Carers

Mr Ratcliffe and I wanted to get in touch and let you know our plans for this Half Term. We are excited about the term ahead and are looking forward to the lead up to the Christmas break. If you would like to support your child's learning at home, we thought it would be helpful for you to have a more detailed idea of what we are learning about.

Core Subjects

English GCSE and Unit Awards

This half term our focus is on nonfiction writing. We will study speeches, blogs and travel writing and try our hand at writing our own nonfiction texts in each of these genres. We'll also cover a few poems from the GCSE collection on power and conflict including some WW1 & 2 poetry on remembrance day. Alongside this we will be developing our exam skills and undertake a mock exam to help students encounter the skills required for success in exams.

Maths GCSE and Entry Level Certificate

In Maths students will continue to work through the curriculum topics while focusing on related examples of past paper questions. In this way, we can show students the type of questions they will encounter and work through them together.

Science GCSE

This half-term Year 10 will be studying Chemistry, specifically finishing the Atomic Structure topic then Bonding between atoms. Year 10 will also cover Physics, specifically energy resources. Year 10 are now set up on the revision platform Seneca, which they can access using their school google log-in. I would also continue to recommend the use of BBC Bitesize for keywords and developing background knowledge.

Computer Science

In the single computer science sessions, we will be working on how to use spread sheets effectively while learning more about calculations in the energy topic of Physics. Then we will be working with PowerPoint effects while completing a project on energy resources and the future.

Computer Science GCSE Option

This term will be learning about data representations within computer systems, how data is transmitted and converted from Binary to Denary and Hexadecimal. We will also be learning about data compression and the links to the wider computer communication systems such as networks and the internet.
