Hot meal update


Thank you to everyone who completed the survey for hot meals in school, unfortunately there is not be enough interest for us to pursue a contract with the company.

Wishing all of our year 11 students a good rest over the Easter period, don't forget to really make these last few weeks count by making the most of your revision time.


This is the final stretch before your exams start (Monday 28th April & Tuesday 29th April – Art) and (Monday 12th May English Literature and Computer Science).

Lots of maths skills in use and excellent levels of focus and ability to follow instructions.








Diversity
